1. Assess Your Eligibility

Age

Meet the minimum age requirement of your state, 18 years old.

Education

Possess a high school diploma, GED or equivalent.

Physical Demands

Be able to perform physically demanding tasks, including lifting, kneeling, and carrying equipment.

2. Choose Your EMT Level

EMT Basic

The entry-level course, providing skills in basic life support (BLS), airway management, oxygen administration, and trauma assessment.

AEMT - Advanced EMT

Builds on EMT-B, adding skills in advanced airway management, intravenous (IV) therapy, medication administration, and cardiac monitoring.



3. Select Your Training Program







Traditional Programs

We offer in-person classroom settings at select RCHS locations. Enjoy live interaction with instructors and classmates, hands-on labs, and clinical rotations.

Online Programs

Our comprehensive online curriculum allows you to learn at your own pace with interactive modules, an eBook, audiobook, and more! Enjoy working at your own pace through the didactic portion, in-person skills, and clinical rotations.

Hybrid Programs

We offer hybrid/virtual classroom settings in our Hybrid Program. Enjoy live interaction with instructors and classmates in a virtual classroom setting, in-person, hands-on labs, and clinical rotations.

4. Enroll and Prepare

Application

Complete the RC Health Services online application and submit your US government- issued ID. It's that easy!

5. Program Structure

Online Didactic Portion (140 hours)

Self-paced, online learning modules covering EMT knowledge and skills.

Skills Days (on-campus)

Practical hands-on training with experienced instructors at select locations across the US (see details below). These can be overlapped with the latter half of the online portion.

Clinical Rotations (externships)

Supervised practice with real patients at affiliated hospitals and ambulance services (locations assigned at the end of the course based on your availability).



Additional Notes

Skills days can be attended at various RC Health Services locations across several states. Some locations have restrictions based on the states EMS program.

Clinical rotations will be attended only at affiliated EMS Agencies.

Program Timeline

You have 6 months to complete the entire program, including online modules, skills days, and clinical rotations.

Required Uniform

- Black or navy blue EMT style pants
- Navy blue polo shirt
- Black non-slip boots
- Black belt
- Watch with visible seconds or timer function
- Manual blood pressure cuff
- Stethoscope

NREMT Cognitive Exam

Take a comprehensive written exam covering all EMT training content. RC Health Services provides comprehensive exam preparation resources and workshops.
